Open Door Permission

Dear Parents:

Although we have an open door policy which means you give permission in writing for your child to leave the Boys & Girls Club, we cannot monitor when they leave or where they go. We have a check-out sheet at the front desk that members with written permission are supposed to sign indicating when and where they are going and when they return. The staff never grants permission for members to leave. This is a decision made by parent and child.

Many children choose to disobey this simple rule and leave the site without having their parent's permission or signing out.

In order for a child to continue to ride the bus to the Boys & Girls Club they must, upon arrival, proceed up the hill immediately and check in at the front desk. Those in violation of this rule, upon their third time, **will no longer be allowed to ride the bus to the club.** Names of members violating this rule will be forwarded to school transportation. Some members proceed directly to the Raley's shopping center upon exiting the bus. This is against club and school rules.

Unfortunately, several of our members have been caught shoplifting at Raley's and we now find it necessary to implement a "good-neighbor policy" which includes suspension from the club for a period of one year for those members in violation of the aforementioned policy. This policy may also affect those members behaving in a disrespectful or disruptive manner off-site.

Rules and Understandings for Club Members

1. There is NO supervision before the Club opens. The children should not be dropped off before 2:00 for the after-school program or prior to daily opening time for summer schedule, and picked up no later than 6PM. At 6:30 PM we will contact the Sheriff's Dept. After ten minutes we will charge \$1.00 per minute per child for late pickups. We are not responsible for any events occurring prior to or after established Club hours.
2. Each child needs to carry membership card while at the Club. Members without Club cards will not be allowed to participate in off-site activities.
3. All program participants will respect each other and staff members. Name-calling, insulting, fighting and violence are never acceptable. This includes racial or sexually oriented comments of any type! Repeated warnings will result in suspension. The amount of days that a member can be suspended will be at the discretion of the supervising staff.
4. Equipment must be used in a safe manner. If there is willful destruction of equipment, there may be a damage fee involved.
5. A parent called for a behavior problem resulting in suspension must see that their child is picked up within one hour of being called, or the alternate numbers given on the membership application will be called.
6. Parents must leave an up to date work number and emergency number list with Club staff.
7. Members should dress appropriately for an active day, and bring sunscreen to use as needed.
8. CD players and Game Boys need to stay at home. The Club is NOT responsible for any personal item of members that are lost, stolen or broken.
9. Children DO NOT need large amounts of money at the Club. We will tell you if there is a field trip or other need for money. The Club is NOT responsible for missing money.
10. There are several lockers. A child will not open anyone else's locker.
11. The Boys & Girls Clubs of El Dorado County Western Slope runs an open door policy program, which means that members can come and go as they desire. The Boys & Girls Clubs of El Dorado County Western Slope will not be held responsible or liable for any member leaving the facility.
12. I hereby give the Boys & Girls Club irrevocable right and permission to use photographs and videos taken of my child at the Club, or at Club events, to be used for promotional and advertising purposes for the Club only.
13. Members MUST observe Club rules!!! Any violation of Club rules will be handled according to Club policy.
14. These rules cannot cover every situation at the Club. When in doubt follow the Club rules or ask a staff member.

Dear parents and Guardians,

Power Hour is designed to enhance your child's day by helping them with their homework. For those without homework, we offer the following options: age appropriate worksheets or reading. For forty five minutes, four days a week, we ask that each member be prepared for Power Hour prior to the beginning of the program. This includes having the necessary supplies and homework copies, visiting the restroom, being ready to Power Up, quickly and quietly, for announcements, and getting quickly settled for work and staying on task for the duration of the 45 minute session. Please make sure your child always has a book to read after his or her homework is completed.

Wandering has always been an issue during Power Hour. Let's not have this problem this year. When a child wanders, he or she always has an excuse, "I don't have homework" or "I need to call my mom" or "Do you have change?" or "The coke machine ate my dollar", etc. These excuses and wanderings disrupt the atmosphere necessary for completing quality homework. Please talk to your child about the importance of Power Hour and all its components.

This year, programs, such as Smart Moves, Art, Club Zoom, and Athletics will be offered before and after Power Hour. For middle school students, programs will be offered at 3:00 pm, most of which will end around 3:45 pm. At 4:45 pm we will offer programs for elementary students. Discussion based and activity programs, such as Smart Moves and Mountain Madness will end around 5:30 pm. Please, if your child is interested in attending a program, make sure that they are able to attend the entirety of the program, as full attendance is necessary for your child to obtain the full benefits of the program. Program schedules will soon be available at the front desk, as well as calendars.
